- Can pick a filler class OR leave hole in your schedule.
- For JATC, leave space in your schedule.

Work Experience



1 period = 32 Hrs/Quarter 2 periods = 64 Hrs/Quarter

- Applications can be picked up in the Counseling Center
- Must have job BEFORE getting application
- ~4 hours a week = 1 period work release
- Up to 2 periods of Work Release as a Junior
- Earn elective credit
- See your counselor in AUGUST to add work experience

For work release, audition/application classes, JATC, online classes, or other classes that you cannot add in Course Requests, leave those periods open for now.

Your plan must fill ! your entire schedule (all 8 periods)

Note: Juniors are <u>not</u> eligible for non-academic (home) release.
