- Talk to your **CURRENT** math teacher for a recommendation.

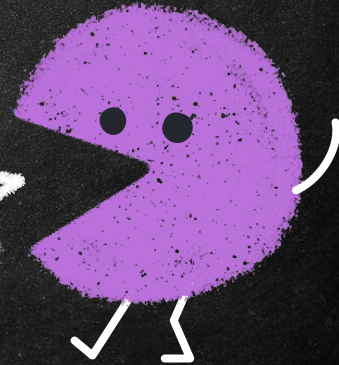




It is STRONGLY recommended that students fit these classes into their 10th grade schedule.

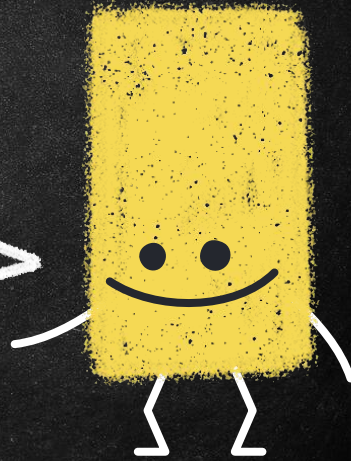

DRIVER'S ED

- Driver's Ed & Careers are taught in same semester
- Your student's birthday determines which quarter they are eligible to take Driver's Ed:

- 1st Quarter: 10/20/2009 - 11/18/2009
- 2nd Quarter: 11/19/2009 - 03/16/2010
- 3rd Quarter: 03/17/2010 - 06/17/2010
- 4th Quarter: 06/18/2010 - 09/16/2010

- STUDENTS MUST HAVE PERMIT PRIOR TO STARTING THE CLASS!



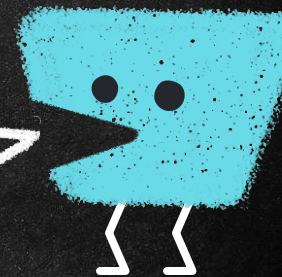

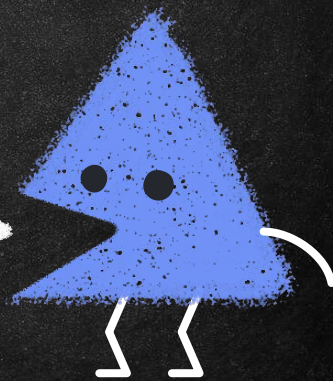

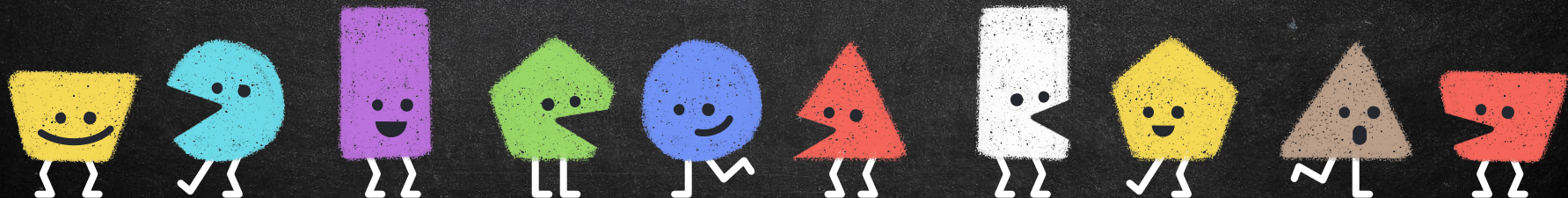
RELEASE TIME (I.E. SEMINARY)

- Seminary is listed as “Release Time” in Skyward.
- You will need to request both sections if planning to do for the entire year.
- Must be enrolled through Seminary to have Release Time in schedule.



AUDITION CLASSES

- An audition class refers to any class you need to audition, try out, or have teacher approval for in order to take.
- Counselor will add into your student's schedule at the request of the coach or teacher.
- Recommended to add an elective class in place of an audition class during Course Requests to hold a spot.
- A list of audition classes is available in your student's registration packet and posted on the BHS website.

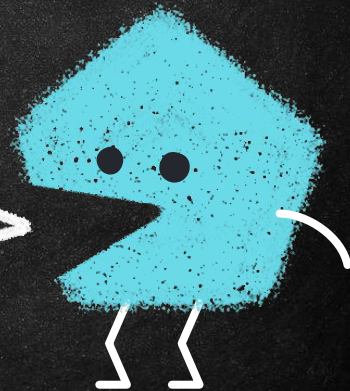
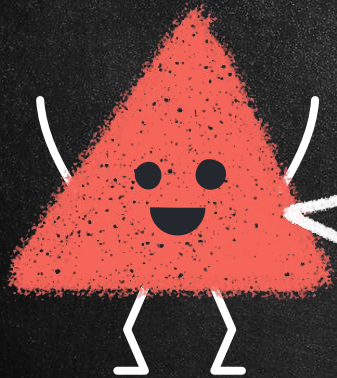
- Most colleges recommend that a student complete at least two (2) years of the same world language.

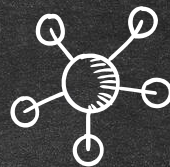
ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP) COURSES



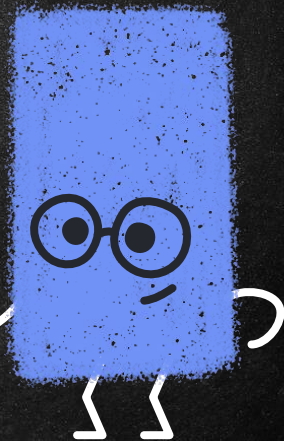
- College-level curriculum classes
- More time, more work, more learning
- End of year AP exam in order to earn college credit
- BHS has over 20 AP classes available!
- 10th grade AP classes: World History, European History, Environmental Science, Pre-Calculus, Spanish, & Chinese



CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT (CE) COURSES



- College class taught at Bingham.
- Earn college credit through SLCC or WSU by passing the class (credit is transferable to other colleges/universities).
- CE grades remain permanently on college transcript.
- BHS offers 30+ CE classes!
- There are 12 CE classes available to 10th graders.
- CE students need to apply for concurrent enrollment admission with [SLCC](#) or [WSU](#) (click on school to access application).



JORDAN ACADEMY FOR TECH & CAREERS (JATC)

→ For students who want to take career-focused classes.



→ 40+ programs including Medical Assisting, Aviation, and Diesel Mechanics.

→ Taught in a two-period block in either the morning or afternoon on A or B days.

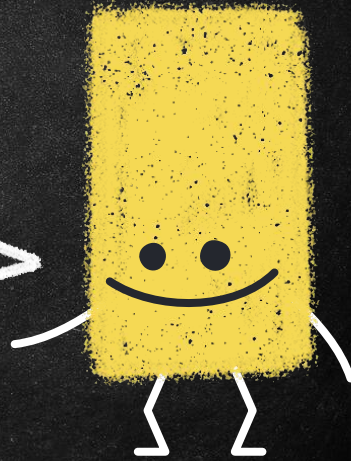

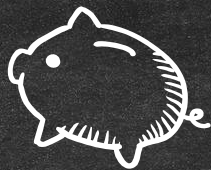

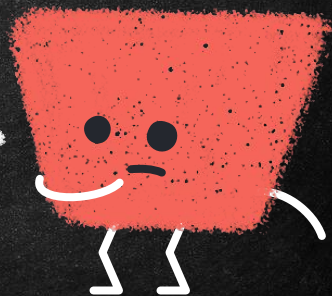

NCAA ELIGIBILITY



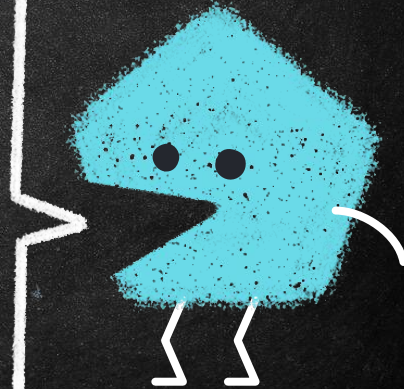
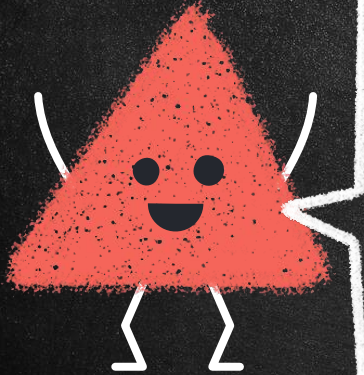
- For students who plan to play college Division I or Division II sports
- Must meet high school graduation requirements, plus those requirements mandated by the NCAA
- Register with NCAA by the end of your junior year
- Achieve a GPA and ACT test index qualifier score
- It is the responsibility of the student & parent to register student with the NCAA and to stay eligible!

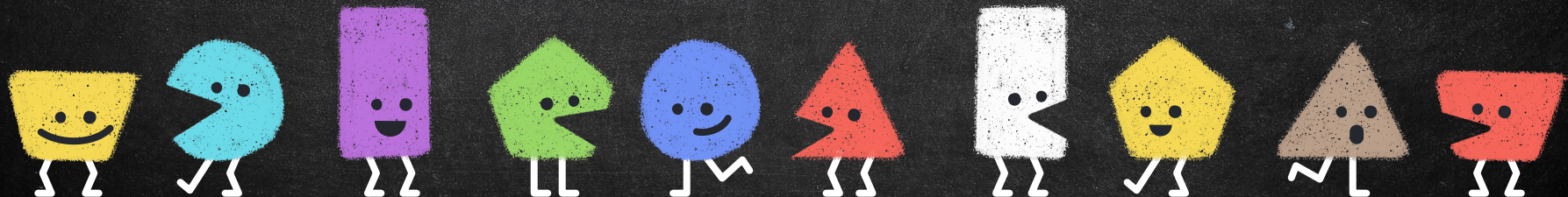

COURSE REQUESTS: WHAT ARE THEY?

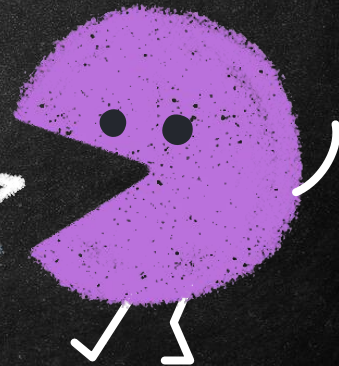
- Gives your student the opportunity to request all of the classes they would like to take next year.

- Parent I.D.



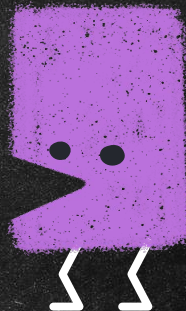
ENROLLING SEATED PERMIT STUDENTS:

CURRENT JSD STUDENT
BUT OUT OF BHS BOUNDARIES

→ Accept Seat on PowerSchool

- ◆ Within one (1) week of acceptance student will show on Skyward as BHS student
 - Middle School will send cumulative file to BHS

**The student's permit application had to have been submitted before 2/7/25 & needs to be accepted prior to course requests. All seats have been awarded for the 2025-2026 school year.*



CREATING A SCHEDULE FOR A NEW STUDENT

- ➔ If your student has already completed the enrollment process, by or before March 11th, course requests can be completed on Skyward.
 - ◆ Instructions on completing course requests can be found on the BHS website under 'Registration'.
- ➔ If your student completes the enrollment process **by or before May**, your student may create their schedule on Arena Scheduling when it opens on May 1st.
- ➔ If your student completes the enrollment process **after May**, you will need to call the BHS Main Office in JUNE to schedule a New Student Appointment with your counselor in AUGUST.
