Financial Aid

Most colleges use the FAFSA score to award needs-based scholarships. Most scholarships, including Opportunity Scholarship, requires FAFSA completion. We encourage all students to apply for FAFSA.

- Apply for Studentaid.gov account # starting immediately (student and parent)
- FAFSA Application Opens in October 1 (tentatively)
- Studentaid.ed.gov or the myStudentAid app
- A dependent student will need to have legal parents sign the FAFSA form so the parent needs a Studentaid account # as well
- You should receive your Studentaid # by email within 3 business days
- You need a Studentaid # to complete the FAFSA application

By completing the FAFSA, you can be awarded Scholarships, Work Study, Grants or Loans

College Preparation Checklist

- ☐ Be on track for high school graduation
- ☐ Take the ACT or SAT college entrance exam
- ☐ Check college admissions and financial aid deadlines and apply early
- ☐ Check college websites for admissions and scholarship applications online
 - ☐ Apply in advance of deadlines as scholarship money goes fast
- ☐ Follow directions carefully for admissions and scholarship applications
 - ☐ Request a TRANSCRIPT through PARCHMENT and select the college of your choice
 - ☐ Parchment Password
- ☐ Pay the application fee (where applicable)
Search out possible sources of financial aid and be careful to meet deadlines
 - ☐ Fill out the FAFSA online application to be eligible for federal financial aid programs at studentaid.ed.gov
Many colleges require the FAFSA be completed to receive needs based scholarships
- ☐ Request letters of recommendation
 - ☐ Give teachers, coaches, employers, counselors, etc. at least two weeks advance notice
 - ☐ Provide written information regarding your strengths, interest, talents, activities, accomplishments, leadership skills and educational plans to your recommenders
- ☐ Plan for housing
 - ☐ Look for on-campus housing applications and deadlines on the college websites- Apply Early!
- ☐ Make your decision and notify the school you will be attending and decline admission for all others you applied to.
